AVID Stands for Advancement Via Individual Determination. AVID is an elective class offered to students who would like to prepare for admission to colleges/universities/post-secondary institutions, but are currently lacking key skills. The curriculum features writing, inquiry, collaboration, organization, reading, note-taking, and study skills, as well as college, career, and motivational activities. The AVID class is an elective that requires a year-long commitment. AVID students must also enroll in Dual Credit and Advanced Placement courses their junior and senior year. College students, or high school students taking college level courses, are in the classroom twice per week as tutors. The AVID selection criteria is centered on 5 major criteria. **Students who are: determined to become more successful in school, the first in their family to attend college, earning a GPA between a 2.0-3.4 (B/C average), historically underrepresented in 4 year colleges, and economically disadvantaged will receive priority acceptance.**
