What to bring

For sports physicals: Students should bring their most recent immunization records and a current list of any medications they are taking. **Parents will need to sign the Health Examination and Consent form:** parents can sign the form at the event or may pre-sign the form which is available at the Mountain Home High School Office or online at: <http://idhsaa.org/manage/articlefiles/99-Consent%20and%20Physical%20Exam%20Form.pdf>.

The sports physicals are offered free of charge.

For immunizations: Central District Health Department (CDHD) will be providing an immunization record assessment and administering all age appropriate childhood vaccines at this event. Your child's vaccination status will not impact their eligibility to play sports. This is an opportunity to vaccinate students and remind parents of other recommended adolescent vaccines. **The Special Event Immunization Consent Form is available at the Central District Health Department or on the internet at <http://goo.gl/JzwshK>** and must be completed and returned with students the day of the sports physicals between 1:00-4:00 pm.

The Special Event Immunization Consent form must be

a) entirely completed on both sides, b) signed & dated, and c) returned with a copy of the student's insurance card.

There is an administrative fee of \$20.13 per vaccine, but there is no charge for the cost of the vaccines. CDHD will bill Insurance/Medicaid for the administration fee(s). For those that do not have insurance, a bill will be mailed directly. Financial assistance is available for families who qualify, the sliding fee scale will slide down to as low as 25% of total cost. **No one will be denied vaccination due to inability to pay.** CDHD staff will assess the student's immunization needs based solely on the records students or families provide. Immunization records accessible via Idaho's Immunization Reminder Information System (IRIS) will also be reviewed if the student is enrolled.
